## Busing Benefits For QAHS

We were fortunate to receive a letter from **Michael Warren '72** bringing to our attention that his father actively contributed to the civil rights movement in Seattle, particularly in the Leschi and Queen Anne communities.

In 1963, Michael's father volunteered for Michael and two of his siblings to be among the first to be bused to the Queen Anne community. They attended West Queen Anne and graduated from Worth McClure and QAHS, with Michael's younger brother **Walter '72** graduating with honors. Warren took some detours through alternative schools before graduating from Queen Anne.

Michael writes that significant events occur when students are bused outside of their communities. This shaped his family's lives, which changed as their "orientation became both 'black' and 'white'."

Along with being a realtor in northern California, Michael is a musician who jokes that his "orientation went from Jazz, Doo Wop and Motown, to the Rolling Stones, The Animals and the Fugs".

As Michael states, "Bused students played a role in shaping QAHS in the '60s and '70s". From Michael's letter this shaping was a positive for the QA High School community.
