To: Applicants for Queen Anne High School Alumni Association Scholarship

Congratulations on your intent to further your education and to pursue school aid through competition for a scholarship award based upon academic and extracurricular activity achievement.

The QAHSAA was founded in 1981, following the closure of Queen Anne High School. Among our purposes is the promotion of education and to keep alive the name and the role of Queen Anne High School in the community. The QAHSAA Scholarship was established for these purposes in 1983, and is awarded annually in the amount of \$1000.00. Additional and /or larger awards may be made, as the scholarship fund grows. Instructions and guidelines for your use in submitting your application follow:

1. Applicants must be former students of Queen Anne High School or direct descendants of Queen Anne students, (children, stepchildren, grandchildren, great grandchildren, etc.) There are no age limits. Applicants must be high school seniors, high school equivalency (e.g. GED) graduates, college undergraduates, or former students seeking post-high school education. Recipients of scholarships are precluded from applying for subsequent scholarship awards. Scholarships may not be used for post-graduate programs.
2. The scholarship may be used at any accredited institution in the United States offering courses leading to a certificate or a degree in the chosen field of a profession or a vocation. **This includes community colleges, and trade/vocational schools, as well as institutions offering academic or fine arts programs.**
3. Payments may be made directly to the institution of the scholarship recipient's choice, **but if that institution is providing financial aid to the recipient, there is a danger that the institution will merely reduce the winner's grant by the amount of the QAHSAA Scholarship amount, thereby negating the scholarship award.** Therefore, the QAHSAA recommends that applicants NOT list this scholarship application on any college application forms and that winners deposit their winning checks in their personal checking account and then write personal checks for their educational expenses in the manner they so choose.
4. The QAHSAA Scholarship Award Committee will base its award on the following:
  - a. A clearly written statement describing the applicant's educational goals and plans;
  - b. Scholastic ability;
  - c. Participation in extracurricular activities, (school, community, sports, church, youth organizations, etc.);
  - d. References.
5. References, on the enclosed forms, are required from two people. One must be from your school principal, teacher or advisor; the other may be from any person. A reference letter may be attached to the Reference Form, **but the form must be completed and signed.**
6. **You must enclose your official school transcript, signed by your school registrar,** indicating your grades THROUGH FALL SEMESTER, your GPA, class ranking (if available) and SAT or ACT scores, if available.
7. Applications must be completely filled out and postmarked no later than midnight, March 31.
